

From Pennsylvania Turnpike:

- a. exit at New Stanton, and take I-70 West to the West Newton exit
- b. At the end of ramp, turn left, then make first right onto Route 31 West
- c. Follow Route 31 West for approximately 5 miles
- d. Route 31 ends and becomes Route 136 West (which is Main Street, West Newton)
- e. Follow Route 136 for approximately 1 mile - a BP Station will be on your left
- f. Go down steep hill; at bottom of the hill, church building is on your left
- g. Turn left onto 3rd Street, go to stop sign
- h. Turn left onto Vine Street, travel 1 block
- i. Turn left onto 4th Street to church parking lot
- j. Watch for men directing traffic (white hats and/or orange vests)

From Pittsburgh, traveling South on Route 51:

- a. Exit at Route 136, and at end of the ramp, turn left onto Route 136 East
- b. Travel approximately 4-5 miles into West Newton
- c. Cross the Youghiogheny River and go through 2 traffic lights
- d. The church building is on your right
- e. Turn right onto 3rd Street, go to stop sign
- f. Turn left onto Vine Street, travel 1 block
- g. Turn left onto 4th Street to church parking lot
- h. Watch for men directing traffic (white hats and/or orange vests)

From Washington, traveling East on I-70:

- a. Exit at Fayette City, Route 201; at end of ramp, turn right onto Route 201 North
- b. Travel under railroad trestle, and bear to the right onto Route 20 North for approximately 2 ½ miles
- c. At intersection, turn right onto Route 201 North and travel approximately 4 miles to junction of Route 136 East and end of Route 201 North
- d. Turn right onto Route 136 East and travel into West Newton
- e. Cross the Youghiogheny River, and go through 2 traffic lights
- f. The church building is on the right hand side on 3rd Street
- g. Turn right onto 3rd Street, go to stop sign
- h. Turn left on Vine Street, travel 1 block
- i. Turn left on 4th Street to church parking lot
- j. Watch for men directing traffic (white hats and/or orange vests)

From Greensburg:

- a. Take Route 119 South to I-70 West
- b. Take I-70 West to the West Newton exit, at end of ramp, turn left and make 1st turn onto Route 31 West
- c. Follow Route 31 West for approximately 5 miles
- d. Route 31 ends and becomes Route 136 West (which is Main Street, West Newton)
- e. Follow Route 136 for approximately 1 mile - BP Station will be on your left
- f. Turn left onto 3rd Street, go to stop sign
- g. Turn left onto Vine Street, travel 1 block
- h. Turn left onto 4th Street to church parking lot
- i. Watch for men directing traffic (white hats and/or orange vests)

From Uniontown:

- a. Travel North on Route 51 to exit for Route 201
- b. At end of ramp, turn left onto Route 201
- c. Travel approximately 1-1 ½ miles to junction of Route 136 East and end of Route 201 North
- d. Turn right onto Route 136 East and travel into West Newton
- e. Cross the Youghiogheny River, and go through 2 traffic lights.
- f. The church building is on the right hand side on 3rd Street
- g. Turn right onto 3rd Street, go to stop sign
- h. Turn left onto Vine Street, travel 1 block
- i. Turn left onto 4th Street to church parking lot
- j. Watch for men directing traffic (white hats and/or orange vests)

From Mt. Pleasant Area:

- a. Follow Route 31 West
- b. Route 31 ends and becomes Route 136 West (which is Main Street, West Newton)
- c. Follow Route 136 for approximately 1 mile - a BP Station will be on your left
- d. Go down steep hill; at bottom of the hill, the church building is on your left
- e. Turn left onto 3rd Street, go to stop sign
- f. Turn left onto Vine Street, travel 1 block
- g. Turn left onto 4th Street to church parking lot
- h. Watch for men directing traffic (white hats and/or orange vests)

General Information:

Registration will be at the lower level entrance to the Social Room (this entrance can be accessed on 3rd Street)

Parking for the meeting is on both sides of S. 4th Street, the church's parking lot, and the parking lot behind the Lutheran Church, located on Vine Street. Watch for men directing traffic (white hats and/or orange vests)
